Job Profile	For this project, the candidate: a) should understanding of proteins like alpha synuclein, neuromelanin involved in Parkinson's disease development. b) should have ability to design experiments on mice to test the effect of different synthesized human neuromelanin and its characterization. c) should have ability to perform in vivo animal model study which includes behavioral studies with mice, stereotaxic surgeries, sectioning of the brain tissues on cryostat. d) should understand molecular biology techniques (ELISA, Western blotting, Immunohistochemistry, RT PCR, etc.) and NGS analysis.
